Collection and Use of Personal Health Information

- Fulfilling any other purpose permitted or required by law

When communicating with your therapist, we want you to be confident that your personal information will be kept confidential.

Your Rights:

You may access and correct your personal health record or withdraw your consent for some of the above uses and disclosures (subject to legal exceptions) by contacting your therapist.

Our Responsibilities:

We take steps to protect your personal health and financial information from theft, loss, unauthorized access, copying, modification, use, disclosure, and disposal.
